Lough Gur House, originally named 'The Grange', a magnificent two storey over basement Georgian structure, was built in 1786.

It was the seat in Ireland of the de Salis family for years. Other families associated with the house over the years include the surnames of O'Connell, Galloway and Matson.

Since 1983, it has been the home of Patrick and Fiona O'Sullivan and family.
